



## **TRACTOR SERVICE & INTERVALS**

Complete maintenance at the proper intervals on your tractor will benefit you for years to come. The tractor will always perform for you and it will be easier on your finances. I will line out some basic service intervals and give some examples of some service tasks we perform on tractors.

Service intervals are as follows. You want to perform an engine or minor service at 50 hours. At 100 hours, do a major or complete service. There after, perform an engine service every 100 hours and a major service every 500 hours. In summary; a minor service every 100 hours and major service every 500 hours. These intervals also apply to older tractors as well.

Most people can change oils and filters but there are many more service items and tasks involved. Some of these tasks are semi-technical and crucial to the tractors longevity. Examples are proper valve adjustments, keeping control levers lubed and moving freely, clutch and brake adjustments, Etc.
